COVID-19 Update

Dear all,

As you will be aware, the Covid-19 pandemic means we are in uncharted territory. During these times, the Council wants to ensure the safety of our residents, staff and our partners as much as possible. To do this the Council has taken the decision to lock park playgrounds, sport equipment and other similar facilities to help prevent the spread of the virus and to help ensure social distancing advice is followed. These facilities will close from today. To reduce pressure on staff, we are also going to leave parks that are normally locked overnight open.

We understand this is a challenging time for everyone and many are following the government advice. However, this is a critical situation and we need to take more serious steps to halt the spread of Coronavirus as best as we can.

We know parks are vital for exercise and fresh air as our mental wellbeing. We currently have no intention of closing our parks, but we will continually review this as circumstances develop. We are urging everyone who needs to go out, to keep a safe 2 metre distance from other people - particularly in our parks.
